Two members of the Department 26 Cycle Club which has seventy members aged 16-68, spoke in support of a cycleway linking north and south parts of the town
- C/367/18**      **To consider the request from Bude Coastal Communities Team for the Town Council to submit an expression of interest for a grant from LEADER (Atlantic and Moor Local Action Group)**  
The Bude Coastal Communities Team (BCCT) had formulated a bid for a cycle path linking Summerleaze and Crooklets beaches. To progress the Town Council would have to formally make the bid and take on the project as landowner of Summerleaze Downs. Different routes and details of a path were discussed, with a seafront path joining or next to the existing footpath being the most likely option. Questions were raised on the shared use of the space, especially with regard to mobility scooters and the effect on disabled people of having a cycle path along side.  
  
The need for planning permission needs to be clarified and BSTC would seek advice. The briefing note of the Town Clerk was noted. Final decisions on the exact details would be made by the Council once the funding bid had been approved.
