Cllr Willingham outlined a request from the Bude Royal British Legion for a Tank Trap to be placed on the lower part of Shalder Hill as a more accessible War Memorial for those who found it difficult to reach the top of Shalder Hill. The TC informed the Committee that CC were moving a number Tank Traps at Crooklets beach, if BSCT would like one then an application would need to be made to the Historic Officer at CC. Discussion took place.

Resolved: that BSTC formally request the relocation of a Tank Trap from Crooklets Beach to a location in the vicinity of the existing War Memorial.
