

Thank you to all who responded to the recent consultation on Summerleaze Downs.


We had a fantastic response – a total of 1844 completed the consultation questionnaire, which exceeded all expectations.

Due to the volume of the data, the Council decided to analyse responses to the consultation in sections.


Decisions regarding the Pitch & Putt Green, the Pavilion and the Old Tennis Courts area, were reached last month.

This month's Full Council Meeting on 17 March will include a discussion surrounding the Skate Park. The Cycle Path will be discussed at a subsequent meeting.


### Are you an EX23 resident or a visitor?

This is huge for the youth in Bude


This is now an Olympic sport.
