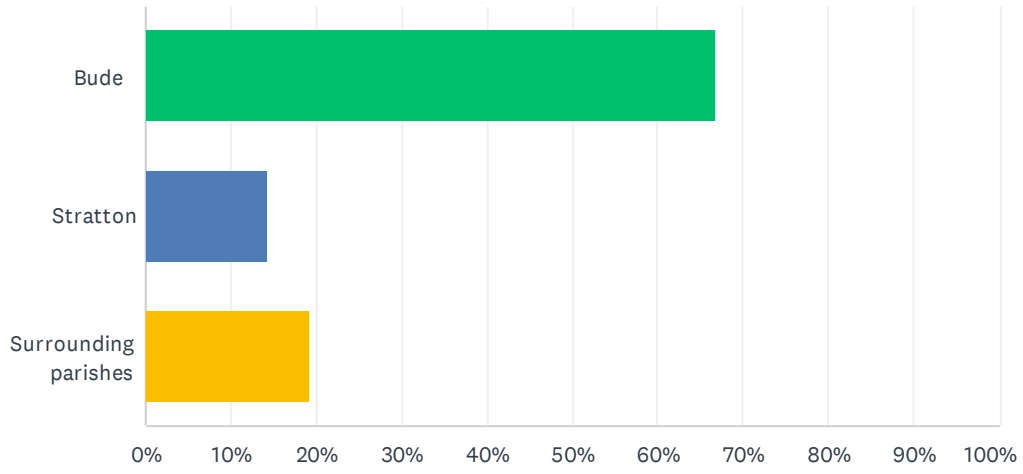


Q1 Where do you live?

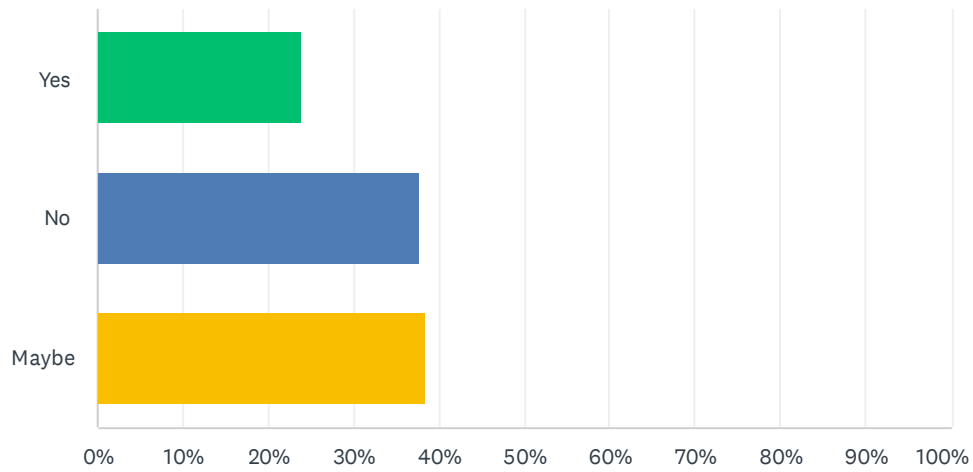

Q2 Would you use a free community 'warm room' this winter?

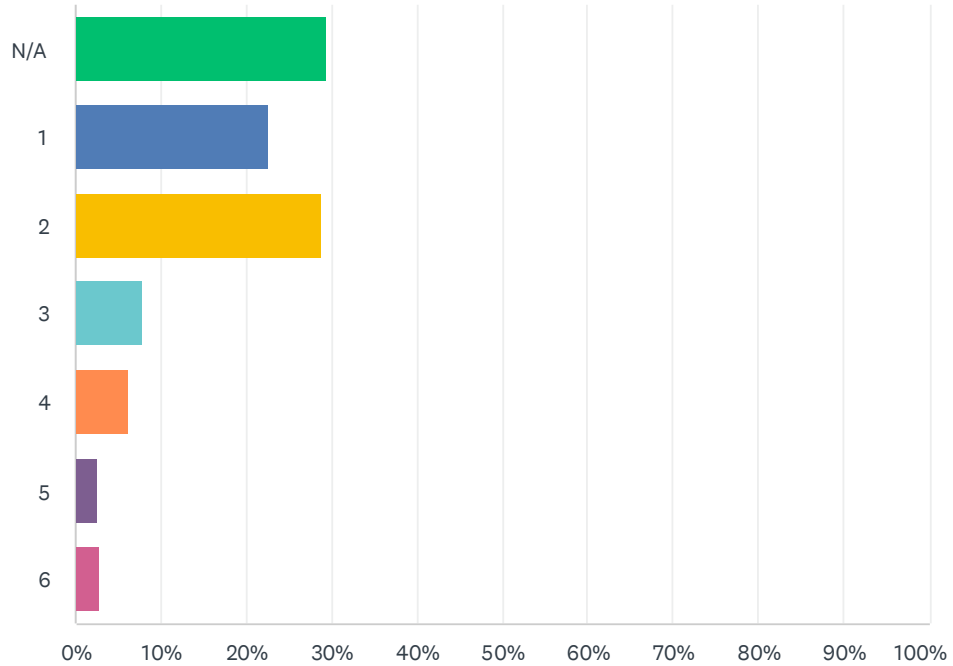

Q3 If you think you may use a community 'warm room' this winter, how many people in your household might this include?

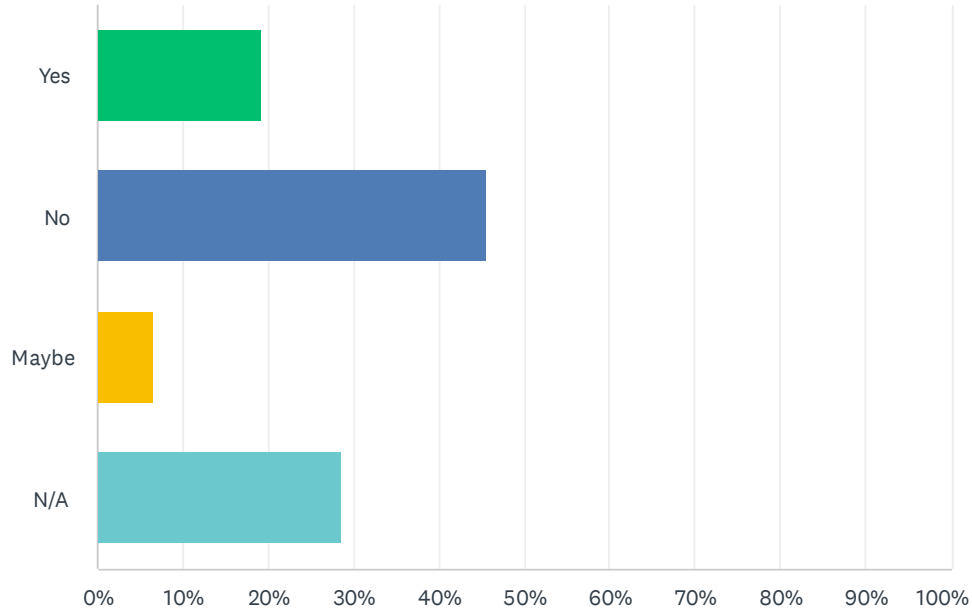

Q4 If you think you may use a community 'warm room' this winter, would you be accompanied by children (under 16)?

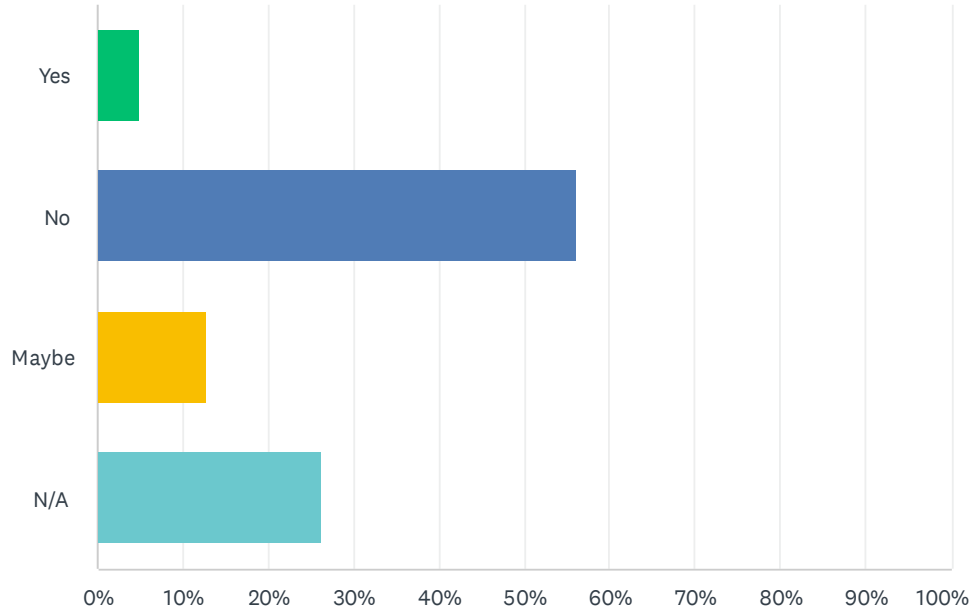

Q5 If you think you may use a community 'warm room' this winter, might you require transport to and from?

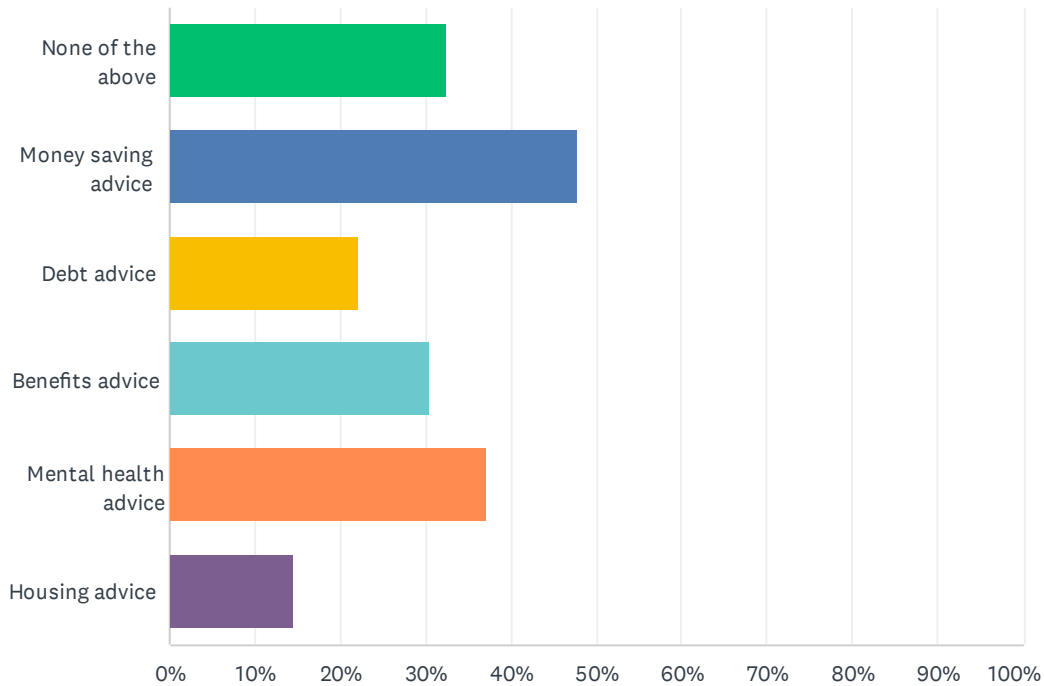
