24 May to the Deputy Returning Officer, Conference Room, The Parkhouse Centre, Ergue-Gaberic Way, Bude EX23 8LD between the hours of 10.00am – 1.00pm and 2.00pm - 4.00pm

If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 22 June 2023**.

Applications to vote by post or to **vary or cancel existing postal or proxy voting arrangements** must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5.00pm** on **Wednesday 7 June 2023** if they are to be effective for this election.

Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5.00pm** on **Wednesday 14 June 2023**, except in cases where **unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment** occurs after that time, in which case applications may be received by no later **5.00pm** on **Thursday 22 June 2023**.
