1. COUNCILLORS TO BE ELECTED

2. NOMINATION PAPERS

3. DELIVERY OF NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination papers **can only be submitted in person** on any day after the date of this notice, but not later than **4 pm on Friday 6th September 2024** to the following location on the specified dates and times:

30 August, 2, 3 and 5 - 6 September 2024 to the Deputy Returning Officer, Cornwall Council, 4S, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro TR1 3AY between the hours of 10.00am – 1.00pm and 2.00pm – 4.00pm

4 September to the Deputy Returning Officer, Cornwall Council, The Parkhouse Centre, Ergue-Gaberic Way, Bude, EX23 8LD between the hours of 10.00am – 1.00pm and 2.00pm – 4.00pm

4. POLLING DAY

If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 3rd October 2024**.

5. Applications to register to vote at this election close at Midnight on Tuesday 17th September 2024.

ABSENT VOTING

New applications to vote by post or to **vary or cancel existing postal or proxy voting arrangements** must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by not later than **5.00pm** on **Wednesday 18th September 2024**. Applications for a postal vote can also be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by not later than **5.00pm** on **Wednesday 25th September 2024**, except in cases where **unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment** occurs after that time, in which case applications may be received by no later **5.00pm** on **Thursday 3rd October 2024**. Applications for a proxy vote can also be made online: www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
